ORDER OF TEMPORARY SUSPENSION

Effective date: 5-24-03

This is a joint petition for a temporary suspension of Jose Pallares. Pallares is currently serving a ninety-day suspension pursuant to our order of suspension, entered on February 7, 2003. This suspension expires on May 24, 2003.¹ Bar counsel and Pallares have stipulated to a temporary suspension under SCR 102(4)(a), to begin on May 24, 2003, pending resolution of additional charges against Pallares.


Having reviewed the petition, we conclude that a temporary suspension is warranted. Accordingly, Pallares is temporarily suspended from the practice of law beginning May 24, 2003, pending the resolution of formal disciplinary proceedings against him. In addition, Pallares shall be prohibited from withdrawing funds in his client trust account, or from any other account containing funds belonging to third parties, except upon bar counsel's written approval or by order of a court of competent jurisdiction. The State Bar shall immediately serve Pallares with a copy of this order. Such service may be accomplished by personal service, certified mail, or delivery to a person of suitable age at Pallares' law office or residence.



When served on either Pallares or a depository in which he maintains an account, this order shall constitute an injunction against withdrawal of the proceeds except in accordance with the terms of this order.²

It is so ORDERED.³


